

Regular care suggestions

- Remember the long term villain DUST is settling daily on your favourite furniture pieces. Highly visible on coffee tables and polished surfaces, dust is quite often unnoticed on upholstered furniture. Yet accumulated dust and grit work their way into the fibres and act like miniature 'grinders' which ultimately lead to the breakdown of even the strongest fabrics. So please take care to vacuum regularly (weekly) using low suction, to significantly extend the life of your furniture.

- When arranging your furniture, take care to avoid touching external walls or radiators. This prevents problems of moisture build-up and/or scorching damage.

- To minimize fading, we recommend placing your upholstered pieces where they won't be exposed to direct sunlight. Even constant exposure to daylight over extended periods without window coverings may cause long term fading.

- Rotate reversible cushions regularly to extend the life of your seating.

- It's difficult to avoid all types of pilling. If it does occur, pilling can be successfully removed with a battery operated pilling tool available at most haberdashery stores.

- A professional cleaning service is recommended every 12 months, but this can change depending on the usage and personal maintenance of your fabric.

Our spot cleaning advice is offered in good faith and is not a guarantee that all stains will be completely removed.

Important reminder

It's a good idea to test your cleaning products on a hidden part of the furniture to ensure fabric and colour are not affected.

Stain Removal From Non Liquid Repellent Fabrics

Warwick Halo's inherent stain resistance allows easy removal for most stains from non liquid repellent treated fabric. Above, soy sauce is easily removed.



Stain Removal From Liquid Repellent Fabrics

Liquid repellent treated fabrics however allow immediate removal of liquid spills. Above, soy sauce is easily removed by use of absorbent cloths to draw off excess liquid.



Handling Stains On Textured Fabrics

Removal of water based pen marks* is possible using detergent based spot cleaners. For textured fabrics, apply cleaning agents to a clean cloth first, not directly to the fabric surface. This method will help prevent channeling of stains into the fabric textures or patterns.

Independent Test Results on Halo Fabrics

These simple cleaning tips will help you deal with some of the most common and difficult household stains like coffee, red wine, make-up, shoe polish and most ink.

Spot Cleaning

Treat spills and stains as soon as possible. Gently scrape any soil or mop any liquid from the surface.

Non-Oil based stains

Use warm water and non-toilet soaps which do not contain optical brighteners; like Velvet Soap, Lux Flakes or Softly. Mix a small amount of soap and warm water and apply to the stain, rubbing gently. Blot dry with a clean towel. Apply cold water and blot dry again. Then with a hairdryer working outward from the centre of the

stain, dry quickly to prevent rings forming. For best results, consider cleaning whole panels of fabric this way.

Oil-based stains

Following the same basic guidelines as above, apply a proprietary brand solvent based cleaner and try to clean in panels rather than spot cleaning. One trade secret is to spot clean oil-based biro marks with the application of Glen 20.

Completing the stain removal process

Once residual stains have been removed, deodorise the affected area to remove any lingering odours. Then re-apply fabric protector to restore any liquid repellency lost during stain removal.
